How this document is to be used:

The children have been set pieces of homework to last over the term.

See if you can buy a newspaper in the shop – how much does a newspaper cost?

Look through the newspaper at home. How is it organised? What is similar about all of the different articles? Can you list the features of newspaper reports?

Research a habitat outside of the UK
– E.G. rainforest or savannah.
Create a factfile about this habitat.

Write a poem about your chosen habitat. You can do this in whichever form you choose.

Our PSHE topic is Keeping Safe. Create a guide for how to stay safe when crossing the road that can be used to help younger children.

Write a short adventure story based near where you live.

Go for a walk on local moorland. Can you identify any of the plants that you see? Even better if you can use a map for this activity. Create a food diary for your weekend. How balanced is your diet?
