English

In English, we will be writing stories with dilemmas, instructions and learning about debates. Later in the term, we will write myths and legends and persuasive letters.

Our class book this term is The Boy at the Back of the Class by Onjali Q Raif.

Throughout all of these topics, we will continue to develop our understanding of spelling, grammar and punctuation. Please support us at home by helping your child with their spellings each week.

Maths

In maths this half term, we will be covering a range topics. These include:

- Fractions
- **Decimals**
- Money
- Statistics
- Time

You can help at home by allowing your children to use real money and supporting them with telling them time throughout the day.

Science

Animals including humans

In this topic, we will learning about:

- Nutrition for animals and humans
- Skeletons and muscles and how our bodies move
- The digestive system including how our teeth function compared to animal teeth.
- Food chains

This topic links back to learning that the children will remember from Class 2.

PSHE

Our first unit this half term is 'Being my Best' followed by 'Growing and Changing' More information about PSHE will be shared in our school newsletter.

Humanities History – Ancient Egyptians Geography - Greece

In history, we will learn about The Ancient Egyptians. We will will locate Egypt, its capital city and the River Nile on a world map; discuss similarities and differences between ancient Egypt and the modern- day Egypt; and explain why it is important to preserve artefacts and buildings from ancient Egyptian times.

Our geography will focus on Greece. We will learn about the human and physical features of Greece as well as the geographical features. Finally comparing Greece with where we live.

In RE, we will be learning about Christianity and what kind of world Christians believed Jesus wanted.

Art and Design Technology

In Art, we will be looking at pattern this term with a focus on the artist Yayoi Kusamo. The children will work towards creating a piece of work in the style of this artist.

In DT, we will be focusing on textiles. We will learn how to do a simple stitch and link this to our history work.

Languages

We will continue to learn French this term learning how to talk about ourselves and our pets.

PE:

PE is usually taught on Mondays. Sometimes, due to changes in the curriculum or weather, P.E maybe taught on an alternative day therefore please provide a P.E kit that is kept in school at all times. This term's PE topics are: gymnastics and dance.

Music

In music, we follow The Sing Up curriculum. Children will learn about pitch and look specifically at samba and carnival music.
